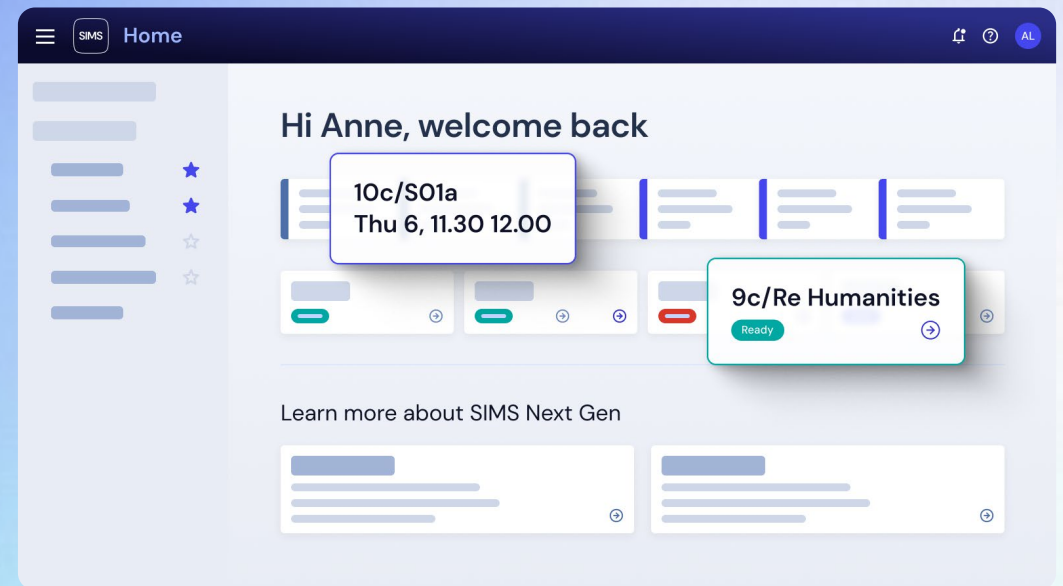


Coming in 2027

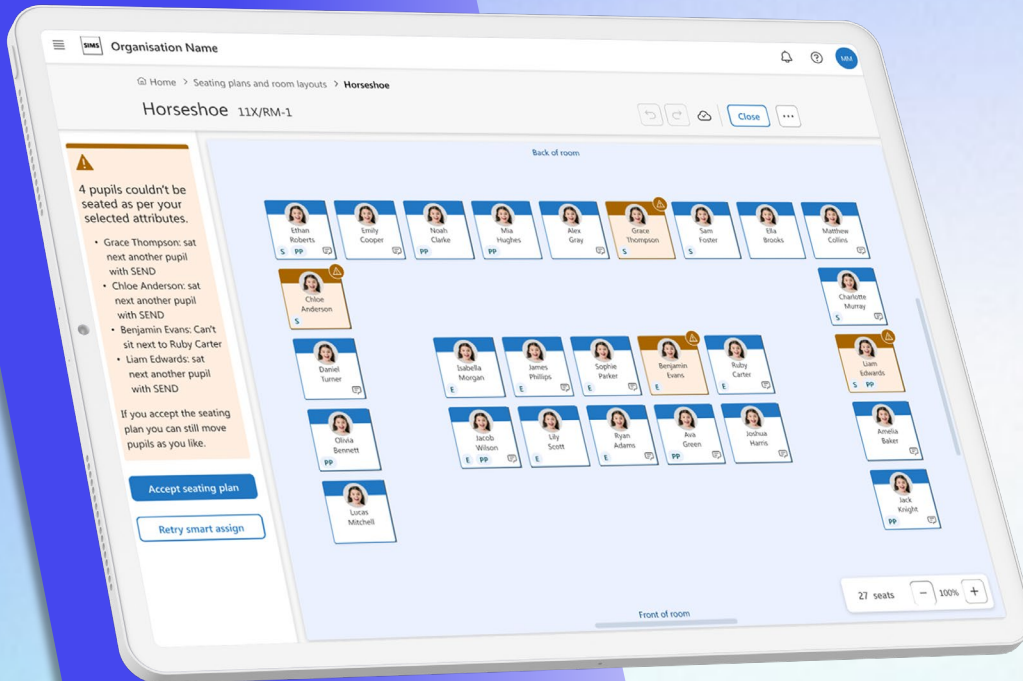
Add natural-language notes to guide seating, from who shouldn't sit together to where pupils sit relative to doors, windows, and other room features.

Respects AI processing consent and flags any instructions it couldn't follow, so teachers stay in control.



Exams Seating

Design and configure exam room layouts, from windows and doors to invigilator desks and power sockets.



Review candidates, clashes, access arrangements, and extra time in one place.



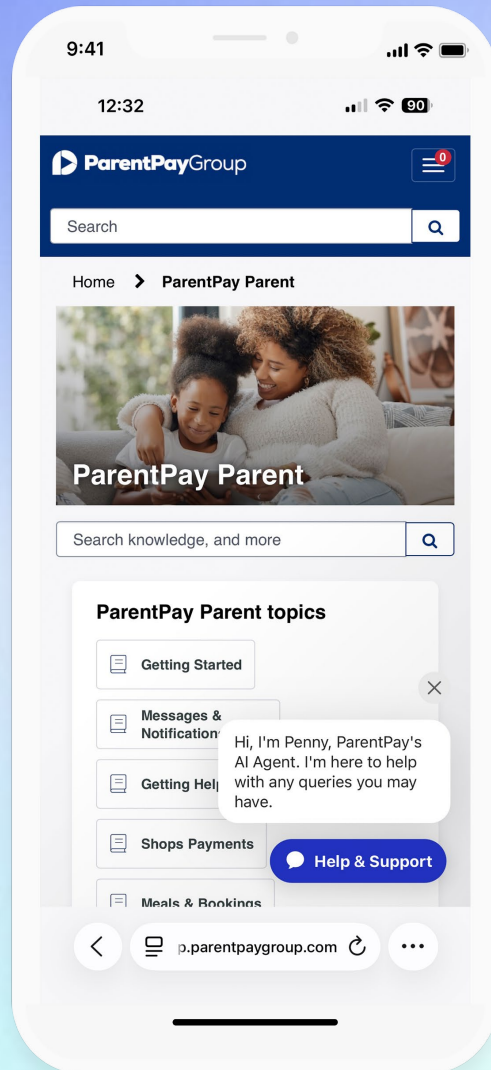
Copy seating plans across components, so officers aren't rebuilding the same layout for every exam.

Invigilation Management

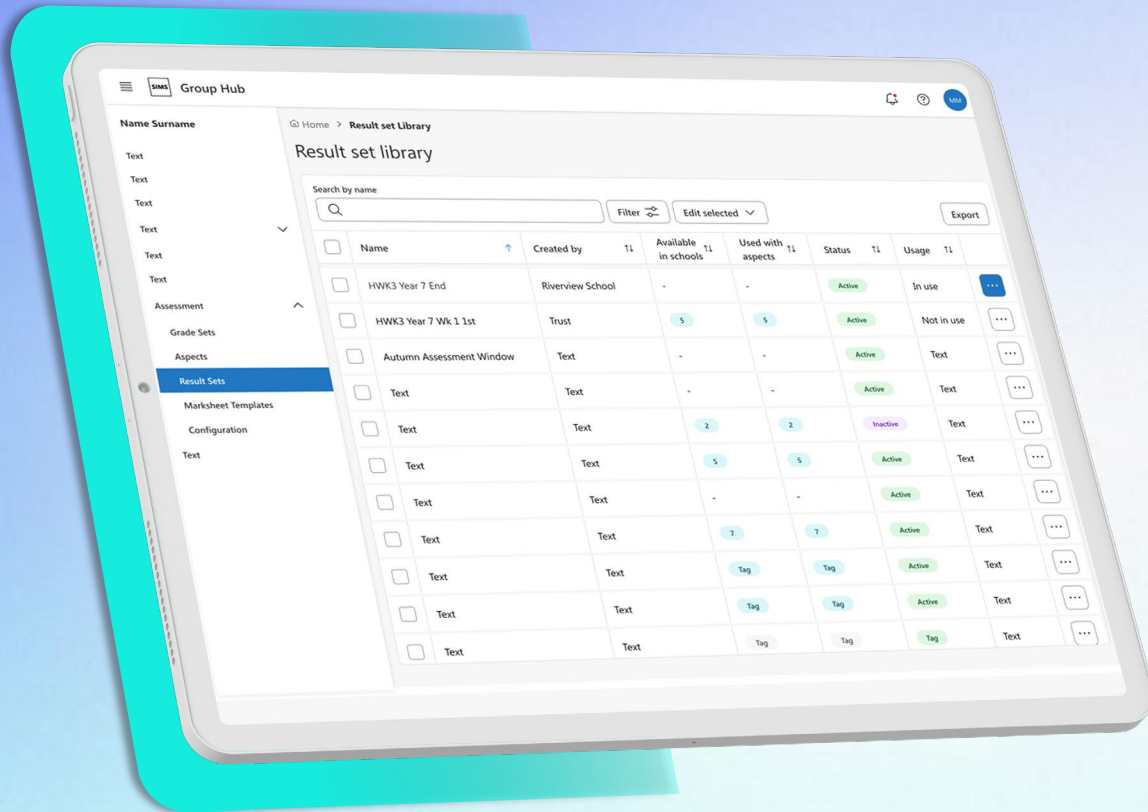

Early 2027 priorities

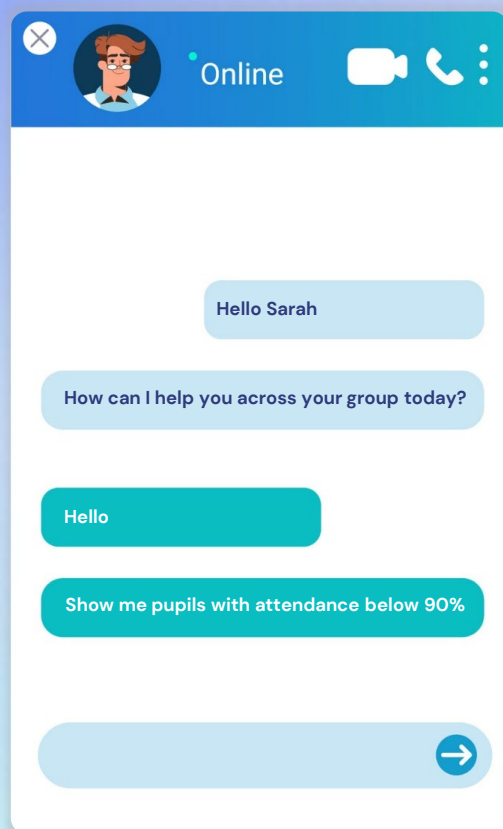


- ✓ Extending Group Hub beyond MATs, to LAs, school groups, federations, and international school groups.

The new virtual assistant is embedded into SIMS and Group Hub offering school and MAT staff help on any questions relating to areas such as attendance, conduct, demographics, interventions and staff absence.



Our assistant will also be further expanded into other group products by the end of 2027.



Workflow automation
